Group Health Participant:

Group health plans sponsored by State and local governmental employers must generally comply with Federal law requirements in title XXVII of the Public Health Service Act. However, these employers are permitted to elect to exempt a plan from the requirements listed below for any part of the plan that is "self-funded" by the employer, rather than provided through a health insurance policy. City of Midland has elected to exempt Plans A & B from the following requirements:

- Protections against having benefits for mental health and substance use disorders be subject to more restrictions than apply to medical and surgical benefits covered by the plan.

The exemption from these Federal requirements will be in effect for the plan year 2022 beginning January 1, 2022 and ending December 31, 2022. The election may be renewed for subsequent plan years.
